

7th Grade Geography - Class Expectations Mr. Washbond, Social Studies Wamogo Regional High School 2015-16



Geography is defined as *the study of the physical features of the earth and its atmosphere, and of human activity, including the distribution of populations and resources, land use, and industries*. By the end of this course, you will be thinking more globally and have a better understanding of the many regions and cultures of the world!

Grading

Grading in this course will be based on a weighted percentages system. The grading value breakdown is as follows:

- Interim Assessments (Quizzes, Blog Entries, Class Work, Short Projects) 35%
- Summative Assessments (Tests, Long-Term Projects, Essays, Speeches) 65%

Notice of assignments/assessments will be given well in advance. Rubrics will be attached to all essays and projects.

Homework

In this course, homework will primarily consist of blog entries, reading, watching videos, and studying. Be sure to complete homework assignments <u>on time</u> so you can get the most out of class the next day!

Tardiness and Absences
